SCM is based in the Lincoln Westmoreland Apartments, a low-income housing complex located at 7th and R Streets, NW, in Washington DC's Shaw neighborhood. SCM's mission is to work together with the children, youth, adults and seniors of the Shaw community to enhance lives and to expand opportunities.

SCM offers after school tutoring for the children and youth, access to a computer lab, nutrition promotion, healthy cooking and exercise classes and actively encourages and empowers promising young people to go to college. Every year, SCM offers college scholarships, summer camp scholarships, career counseling, as well as Thanksgiving baskets and an eagerly anticipated Christmas party.

MARIE REED SCHOOL

Westmoreland has a partnership agreement with the Marie H. Reed Community Learning Center, a public elementary school located at 18th Street and Kalorama Road in the District. 90% of the children at Marie Reed live below the poverty line.

We provide tutors in reading and math, and we support Math and Science Clubs at the school. We have also provided financial support, food for families at Thanksgiving, tables and chairs for the library, and other types of support.

Westmoreland has a number of outreach ministries, including Bethesda Cares, City Gate, Shaw Community Ministry, the Marie Reed school, and our Volunteer Corps. There are many opportunities to contribute funds or provide service to those in need. Volunteers are welcome.
