- Placement process that matches applicant's interests and skills with available positions
- Live in a community grounded in Christian ideals with others committed to service
- Professional community counselor who meets weekly with volunteers
- Welcoming church home with supportive board members who serve as mentors
- Periodic retreats for reflection and evaluation.
