- Potential for AmeriCorps grants and deferred payments for college loans
- Professional community counselor who meets weekly with Volunteers
- Periodic retreats for reflection and evaluation
- Participation in a program centered on the values of service to others, with a welcoming church home and supportive board members who serve as mentors
